

POSITION TITLE: Licensed Bilingual Therapist

POSITION SUMMARY:

Therapist (bilingual Spanish needed) to provide individual, child, marital and family counseling to Spanish speaking families in the offices of Family Services North Department of Catholic Charities Diocese of Arlington in Arlington, Fairfax, and Manassas.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

Provides ongoing out-patient psychotherapy to clients. Demonstrates sound diagnostic skills as well as the ability to carry out a variety of treatment modalities. Meets billable hour expectations. Clinician is expected to build his or her case-load sufficient until 70% of his/her available time is booked with direct service hours.

Maintains high standards of practice, Adherence to high ethical standards as defined in the CCD/CCUSA, NASW, APA and ACA Code of ethics.

Operates on an increasingly independent level, with a high degree of self-awareness, requesting consultation as the need arises. Actively consults or receives supervision from assigned supervisor as needed.

Is willing to travel to provide clinical services from multiple locations.

Completes clinical record keeping within 72 hours of service.

Contributes knowledge and understanding to the agency staff in areas of specialized competence.

Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Arlington provides services grounded in the teachings of the Catholic Church on the human person. Accordingly, the clinician is expected to provide services within this framework.

Takes responsibility for continued professional development through conferences, seminars, etc.

QUALIFICATIONS/EXPERIENCE:

- Masters in Counseling, Clinical Social Work, or Psychology
- Clinical experience from a post-graduate program
- Licensed (LCSW or LPC) in the Commonwealth of VA or license eligible within 6 months of hire.
- Ability to work a flexible schedule including 2 nights per week
 - Experience needed is the equivalent of two years full time clinical experience.
 - Additional training and experience for working with children, families, trauma and/or domestic violence.
 - Fluent in Spanish-verbal and written.

Physical Abilities for Performance of Duties:

- Sensory functions sufficient to perform physical tasks around the office (moving supplies, furniture, etc.), participate in social work services, operate office machinery, and perform major duties outlined above.
- Ability to sit for extended periods of time (one hour or more,) provide casework services and participate in meetings; possess a valid driver's license and to travel to district offices.
- Vision and hearing abilities sufficient to engage in counseling services and supervise social workers; ability to communicate with clients and supervisees.

Supervision: The Family Services North Therapist is evaluated by his or her assigned supervisor within the Family Services North Department of Catholic Charities. Job performance is evaluated in terms of effectiveness in achieving goals set at the evaluation (e.g., case loads, special projects, outreach, and clinical dictation) and in terms of professional conduct.
